

**2012 SCHOOL DISTRICT WARRANT  
EAST KINGSTON SCHOOL DISTRICT  
STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE**

To the inhabitants of the School District of the Town of East Kingston, County of Rockingham, State of New Hampshire, qualified to vote upon District affairs. You are hereby notified to meet as follows:

**FIRST SESSION:** At the **East Kingston Elementary School** in said East Kingston on **Monday, February 6, 2012, at 6:30 p.m.** for explanation, discussion, debate, and possible amendment of the following warrant articles:

1. Shall the School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$2,578,654? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$2,602,117, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the District or by law, or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. (Majority vote required.) (The School Board recommends \$2,578,654 as set forth on said budget.)

NOTE: This warrant article (operating budget) does NOT include appropriations in ANY other warrant articles.

2. To see if the School District will vote to enter into a collective bargaining agreement with the East Kingston Teachers' Association (the union representing the teachers in the School District school) covering the two year period from September 1, 2012 to August 31, 2014, and approve cost items included therein containing, in summary: continuation of other non-salary benefits; and salary increases so that the approximate increase in the cost of teacher salaries and salary related expenses because of this agreement and step increases for each of the two years (subject to change resulting from changes in the number of and in the educational degrees and years of experience of teachers employed) over the preceding year will be:

Year	Estimated Increase
2012 – 2013	\$39,186
2013 – 2014	\$31,964

And, further to raise and appropriate the sum of \$39,186 for the 2012-2013 year, such sum representing the net additional costs attributable to the increase in the salaries and salary related benefits over those included as part of Article 1, the 2012-2013 operating budget. (The School Board recommends this appropriation.)

3. To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000) for the purpose of partial roof replacement at the East Kingston Elementary School. (Majority vote required.) (The School Board recommends this appropriation.)
4. To hear reports of agents and committees or officers heretofore chosen.
5. To transact any other business which may legally come before the meeting.

**SECOND SESSION:** At the **East Kingston Elementary School** in said East Kingston on **Tuesday, March 13, 2012**, to choose the following School District Officers:

- One School Board Member for a three (3) year term ending 2015;
- One School District Moderator for a one (1) year term ending 2013;
- One School District Clerk for a one (1) year term ending 2013;
- One School District Treasurer for a one (1) year term ending 2013;


and vote on the articles listed as 1, 2, and 3 above, as those articles may be amended at the First Session; by ballot, the polls to open at 8:00 a.m. and to close no earlier than 7:00 p.m.
