

Home or hospital instruction shall be authorized by the Superintendent:

1. To any child with a health or physical impairment which, in the opinion of a licensed medical examiner, will cause him or her to be absent from school for more than two consecutive weeks and who school personnel determine can educationally benefit from such a program; or
2. To any child whose educational needs, as determined by a case study and reviewed in a multidisciplinary staff conference, are most appropriately and effectively met by such a program.
