The school district fully recognizes and values the importance of sound educational research. However, certain safeguards and requirements must be met by any individual or organization wishing to involve local children in education research. Any requests of staff members and/or non-staff members wishing to conduct private educational research must meet the following criteria:

- (a) The Principal and the Superintendent will evaluate each proposed research project. Their recommendation to the Board will be based on this evaluation.
- (b) All requests for conducting either individual or group research must be approved by the Board.
- (c) Once the Board approves a particular research project, parental approval must be obtained by the school prior to initiating the research project.
