

## CIVICS/GOVERNMENT – K

**Appropriate Behavior** – to act suitable or properly for the occasion

**Citizen** – a person who is born in a country or who chooses to become a member of a country, city or town.

**Community** – a group of people living in the same area such as a city or town

**Community Helpers** – a group of people living in the same area such as a city or town who provide support, aid, or service, as in doing a task.

**Directions** – an order or instruction about how to proceed or act

**Responsibility** – having as a job, duty, or concern

**Rules** – directions regulating behavior, procedures, or action

**Safety** – freedom from danger, injury, or risk; being safe

**Trusted** – a person or thing that is believed or believed in

## GEOGRAPHY – K

**Down** – from a higher to lower place, level, or position; in a descending direction; toward the ground

**Globes** – the earth; world

**Left** – the left side or direction

**Maps** – a drawing of a real place that shows the place from above

**Name of Country** – a word by which an area of land is known

**Name of Town** – a word for a group of houses and public and private buildings, larger than a village but smaller than a city

**Right** - the right side or direction

**State** – a body of people living together under one government

**Up** – from a lower to a higher place, level, or position

## HISTORY – K

**Celebration** – the ceremonies or festivities carried on to observe an event or honor a person

**Flag** – a piece of cloth having various colors and designs on it that is used as a symbol of a country or organization, or as a signal

**Future** – that is to be or happen in time to come

**Holiday** – a day on which most people do not work, especially a day that is fixed by custom or law to celebrate a special event

**Past** – having happened or existed in time gone by

**Present** – existing or going on at this time

**Today** – the present day, time, or age

**Tomorrow** – the day after today

**Yesterday** – the day before today

## ECONOMICS – K

**Adults** – a grown men or women; mature persons

**Career** – an occupation or profession

**Coins** – a piece of metal stamped with official government markings and of fixed weight and value, used as money

**Job** – a position of work; employment

**Money** – the coins and paper currency issued by a government for payment of debts and for purchase of goods and services

**Service** – a system or means of providing something useful or necessary, especially for the general public
