Goals 2007-2008

- I. Goal: Ensure year one of renovation is executed according to plans and with minimal disruption
- a. Continue to work with construction company and architect to see that expectations are met **Ongoing through June, 2009**
 - b. Continue to inform/educate SST constituency on renovations throughout project **Ongoing through 2010**

 - b. Begin to lay the foundation for a (post-renovation) Middle School summer school program at SST addressing drop-out prevention **June 2009**
 - c. Collaborate with present and future tenants of the Tuck Learning Campus on everything from building safety to sharing teachers and classrooms **Ongoing**
 - d. Make resources at SST open and available to senior citizens during early hours and later hours as appropriate (post-renovation) **June 2009**
 - e. Explore flexible school hours that may be appropriate for certain programs and students such as an evening CA program which serves dinner **June 2009**
