

1. Any school district that provides a food service program, regulated by the U.S. Department of Agriculture and State Department of Education, or any other entity with proper jurisdiction, shall make available to all children of low economic means and children of moderate income families experiencing financial difficulties free or reduced-price meals through the School Nutrition Program.
2. Parents who believe their children are eligible may contact the principal and a determination will be made relative to their eligibility. Parents may appeal a negative determination to the Board and the Superintendent.
