PLACEMENT OF TRANSFER STUDENTS:

The administration of Great Bay eLearning Charter School will determine which competencies and proficiencies transfer students have met in other academic settings. Any of the following may be used in making this determination:

1. a review of all existing school records or credit transcripts,
2. a review of the previous educational program including, but not limited to, time spent in program and curriculum requirements of the program, and IEP when applicable,
3. a review of student work from individual subject areas or grade levels,
4. an interview of the student and/or parents by the principal or designee, and/or
5. project performance during a probationary period to be established by the administration.
